Extract from full transcript

SK: Simon (K)ampanellas

AD: Cypriot Superintendent Andreas DEMETRIADES (as Frixos Nicolaides)

SK: I've thought all this up just now....you'll understand how my brain works. Before talking to you I had no idea what I was going to say to you.

AD: Aha.

[Six lines omitted for brevity.]

SK: I've put in so much money. I myself have half a million which I can invest in Cyprus as from tomorrow. I could tell my bank to send you half a million dollars.

AD: To do what job?

SK: I do a thousand and one jobs. There isn't anything I don't do. Clothes, medicines, satellites, telephone equipment, electronics..er..everything.

AD: I see.

SK: You know, I'm.....there isn't a thing....If you knew some of the things I'm doing now, you'd laugh. I do....I have groups, we're making music, films, video. I have...I work for.....I have....I'm doing research into AIDS.

AD: Are there many who have AIDS over there?

SK: Well, they're all...you see, half the people from 15 years up...er...four out of every five people... three or four are going to die from AIDS. As things stand at the moment, that is. Even if they were to stop it tomorrow, a quarter of England's population is done for.

AD: I see.

- SK: I myself am putting my money, all the money I now have into helping the starving children of Africa. people who suffer from a disease of the brain..er..I don't know what it's called.
- AD: Cancer?
- SK: What?
- AD: Is it like cancer?
- SK: No, no, it's not cancer. There is a lot who have that. This is a mental illness.
- AD: Aha.
- SK: Children who are born with a brain that isn't functioning properly.
- AD: Yes, I see.
- SK: And for this thing 'AIDS'. And a hundred other things. I'm doing research at present into killing off all the mice and rats that eat the food of the poor people. And it's with fleas and snakes that we are going to kill them.
- AD: Aha.
- SK: You see, I'm thinking....my brain is working away. My work is ideas. There it is. God has created me with this gift, to be able to think very precisely and very clearly about a lot of things. But I'll tell you, I'm not an educated person. Not even one..er..what do we call them? 'O' level. Do you know what that is?
- AD: Yes, 'O' levels, that's the GCE.
- SK: I don't have a single one.
- AD: You don't?
- SK: No, I don't. I left school at fifteen and went round the world. My Mother and Father didn't know where I was. I went to Africa, I went to..er..India...you know, I spent my first ten years...I didn't even work. I just toured the world to discover life's truths.
